Setup

- Cards of different colors, 1-5
- Three 1s,
- Two 2s,3s,4s
- One 5

- 7 Hints
- 3 hit points



The TWIST!

You may not look at your cards!



• The rest can give you hints, but limited

• You must act on the information you're given and what you can infer.

Turns

- Three options:
 - Play a card onto the table
 - Discard a card (get a hint token back)
 - Ask for a hint (costs one token)

• If you used a card, draw back up to 5 cards



Play Rules

- Put in order from 1 to 5 by color
- Can only play a card once the previous is on the table (except #1)
- No Doubles!



Hints

- Can only tell ONE PLAYER either:
 - The amount of a certain number they have
 - Or
 - The amount of a certain color they have


